

SCT MARINE 3 Year Hull & Frame Product Warranty

Interpretations:

- SWAG Camper Trailers Pty Ltd referred to herein as 'SWAG' and/or 'SCT Marine'
- Hull & Frame referred to herein as 'the Boat' or 'boat'

Our liability for the boat is limited to making good any defects by repairing to the same or, at our option, by replacement within a period not exceeding thirty-six (36) calendar months after the boat has been sold by a dealer for the first time, subject to the SCT-Marine Three Year Limited Warranty Special Provisions.

Please note: For warranty conditions on your outboard motor and Trailer, refer to their applicable owners' manual supplied with these items.

Our goods come with guarantees that cannot be excluded under the Australian Consumer Law. You are entitled to a replacement or refund for a major failure and for compensation for any other reasonably foreseeable loss or damage. You are also entitled to have the goods repaired or replaced if the goods fail to be of acceptable quality and the failure does not amount to a major failure.

SCT-Marine boat warranty special provisions require that:

1. The boat must be maintained and used in accordance with the Boat Capacity Plate and The Necessary of alloy boats listed in this warranty.
2. The boat and/or outboard/inboard engine must not have been altered
 - a. from factory standard
 - b. or operated outside safe boating practices
 - c. or the limits of the design specifications changed.
3. The boat must not have been damaged by neglect, accident, improper use or used for competitive and/or commercial purposes.
4. The warranty does not cover any consequential expenses beyond the warranty repair of the boat itself, e.g. Freight.
5. The warranty does not cover electrical cabling, electrical systems, fixtures, general fittings, light bulbs, rubbers, consumable products or general wear & tear.

7. SWAG shall not be liable for consequential loss of any kind arising out of the supply or operation of the boat.
8. Paint is warranted against defective paint or application, NOT against the normal effect of oxidization and degradation caused by fuel and dissimilar metals.
9. The normal effect of oxidisation of aluminium has the potential to bubble paint surface finish. Surface contaminates could cause oxidisation if not removed from the vessel.
10. Internal side panels are warranted against defects and not against degradation caused by fuel.
11. The fitting of wedges and anti-ventilation plate foils to the outboard/inboard engine will void the warranty (refer to special provision 2).

12. Any work agreed to be repaired by SWAG will be done ex-factory, and freighting costs to and from the factory will be the purchasers responsibility. The warranty does not cover items replaced during normal service and maintenance operations and which are subject to wear. These arrangements apply regardless of any change in ownership during the period covered.
13. Subject to item 12, the above warranty is in lieu of any and all warranties expressed or implied, conferred by statute or otherwise and is the only warranty given by SWAG on the boat or any part thereof. Any warranties under the Sale of Goods Act are expressly excluded.
14. All warranties and conditions implied under the Trade Practices Act, including as to one of merchantable quality, are not excluded by this warranty except that SWAG limits its liability for breach to:
 - a. the replacement of the boat or products; or
 - b. the repair of the boat or products, at Swag's option with all freighting costs to be the purchaser's responsibility.
15. Excludes windscreen/windshield breakage and leakage around windscreens/windshields or other designed openings.
16. SWAG provides a general warranty as to the 'fitness for the purpose' for the period of 12 months from the date of purchase about upholstery, including lounges, backrests, and seats.
17. SWAG will NOT warrant boats, which have been improperly trailed. E.g. the use of multi roller trailers, Incorrect or insufficient tie down from vessel to trailer, no engine support through an engine support bracket and off road trailer or vehicle use.

Commercial Use

SWAG **does not** warrant boats used commercially.

Maintenance of Alloy Boats

The **ONLY** way to maintain an aluminium boat is to wash it regularly and after every use, with soap and fresh water. You must Coat it with a high-quality marine wax at least once a year to protect the paint and protect against fading. If you don't do this, oxidation will occur on the surface of the aluminium.

- NEVER use harsh chemicals on the hull
- ONLY Clean with fresh water. NOT bore water
- NEVER leave the boat in wet environments for prolonged periods
- ALWAYS store your boat under cover and away from environmental factors such as sun, rain, hail etc.
- NEVER pressure wash
- Customers MUST only use high quality marine wash down products, soft brushes and microfibre products.
- Clean all windows, seals, vinyls, upholstery with microfibre nonabrasive cloths.
- DO NOT leave metal sinkers or metal products in the hull
- Customers should invest in marine protective products such as Lanolin or WD40.
